A DPJCC Supervised, Remote Learning Program

Grades K-8

Beginning August 19, 2020



What is JSchooled?

JSchooled is the DPJCC's new program offering adult supervision for your children if and when they are not in school. Broward County has announced that they are not returning to school in person and instead their program will be virtual or remote learning. The DPJCC is here to help oversee your child's remote learning, including assisting logging in and out of all platforms, turning assignments in online and helping with school work if time allows.

JSchooled staff are NOT the teachers and we are not a substitute for your child's education. Instead, we are here to HELP with your child's remote learning experience.

- JSchooled also ***includes PE & enrichment classes*** that are included in your JSchooled fees.
- Students need to ***bring their own labeled device*** (laptop or iPad), headphones and charger.
- DPJCC has invested in upgrading to ***faster internet speeds and improved WiFi***.



Days, Hours & Times

- JSchooled is available on Monday through Friday, according to BCPS calendar.
 - *Note: DPJCC is closed for two additional Jewish Holidays, including Passover 3/29/21 & Shavuot 5/17/21*
 - *JSchooled will be open for teacher planning days: 10/19/20, 11/3/20, 3/19/21, 6/10/21*
 - *JSchooled is not open for MLK & Presidents Day; Winter & Spring Breaks are not included.*
- Hours are from 7:30am to 2pm.
- Drop off in the morning is from 7:30am to 9am.
- Currently, we are prioritizing the five (5) day registrations.
- We will accept two (2) and three (3) day registrations and they will be put on a waiting list, and if space allows, we will contact you.
 - Three day is Mon/Wed/Fri only and two day is Tues/Thurs only.
- Pick up is at 2pm unless you also enroll in the DPJCC After-School program, 2-6pm.
- We also offer JSchooled Plus from 2-3:45pm if you also want to enroll in DPJCC enrichments which begin at 3:45pm.



Staffing & Supervision

JSchooled is staffed by:

Health & Safety Precautions

Health and safety are our top priority:

- We will abide by all CDC, DOH and local Broward County guidelines.
- Social distancing within classrooms and public spaces will be enforced.
- Two students will be sitting at opposite ends of 6-8' tables divided by plexi-glass dividers for safety, and spaced 6' or more apart from other tables.
- JSchooled is housed in the After-School/Adult Services wing with it's own dedicated restrooms. They will only be leaving that dedicated space for PE, Swim and Hip-Hop.
- Face coverings will be required by students and staff at all times (except while eating and drinking).
- Classrooms, surfaces, bathrooms and hallways will be sanitized throughout the day and nightly with our electrostatic disinfectant sprayer. JSchooled is assigned a dedicated maintenance staff member.
- Daily health checks including temperature, exposure and symptom screening.
- Dedicated infirmary staffed by EMT.



Grouping of Classes/Cohorts

JSchooled class assignments will be made by a number of variables:

- Hours: The hours that a student is attending (2pm pick up vs. 6pm pick up)
- School: The school that they attend
- Platform(s): The online platform(s) each student is using
- Grade level: We will do our best to group classes by grades; most likely classes they will be grouped in a grade range. Example: K-1 or K-2, or 2-3 and 4-5.
 - We will try to group Kindergarten as it's own cohort.
- # of Days: - If we do accept 2 and 3 day registrations, then groups will also be determined by the # of days they are registered for. Example: M/W/F and T/TH would be assigned to a group and 5 day students would be grouped together.



Schedule of Day (PE & Enrichments)

The schedule for each child and class will vary depending on each child's remote learning schedule.

Sample day could look like:

7:30-8am	Arrival, preparation for remote learning
8-9:45am	Remote learning
9:45am	Snack Break
10:05am	Remote Learning
11am	PE Class
11:30pm	Lunch
12-1:30pm	Remote Learning/Homework
1:30pm	Enrichment Class/Specials
2pm	Dismissal

Enrichments for fall session may include: swim, art, hip-hop and robotics. Robotics and art may take place in their JSchooled classroom; Hip-Hop will take place in Studio A; swim will take place in the pool.

PE classes will vary and could include: tennis, pickleball, soccer, kickball, fitness, track & field



Snack & Lunch

Snack

Daily individual snacks (kosher and nut-free) will be provided every morning.

Lunch

For lunch you have 2 options:

- You can bring in a dairy lunch from home.
- You can purchase lunch – for \$6 per lunch - through the DPJCC on a monthly basis. You can choose your lunches by the day, but they must be purchased on a monthly basis.
 - Lunches are provided by Sterling Kosher Caterers. Menus and registration will be provided prior to JSchooled starting. Payment is made on a monthly basis to the JCC.



After-School Options

- You can choose to pick up at 2pm, when JSchooled is over, through carpool only.
- You can choose to bundle JSchooled with After-School which runs from 2-6pm.
 - A 10% discount is built in to the JSchooled and After-School bundle.
- If you choose to enroll in our After-School program from 2-6pm, your child cannot take any enrichments and return to the After-School program like they used to.
- Once your child goes to an enrichment class (ex. at 3:45pm), they cannot re-enter the DPJCC After-School program on that same day; parents would need to pick up from the enrichment class that day.
- We are offering **JSchooled Plus for an additional \$10 per day from 2-3:45pm** if you also want to enroll in DPJCC enrichments which begin at 3:45pm. Once you enroll your child in an enrichment, please advise Lisa Lundy in the Children & Family office that you want to add on JSchooled Plus for that day for the fall session.

JSchooled has very limited spaces available. Registration deadline is July 31.

A non-refundable registration fee of \$125 is required for every student.

After July 31, registration fee is \$175.

Private & Semi-Private Tutoring are available for an additional fee.

Tutoring fees will be available soon.

Tutoring sessions can be booked during JSchooled day or afternoons, evenings and weekends.



How to Register & Priority Registration

- You can register by going online to www.dpjcc.org/jschooled
- Priority registration will be given to:
 - 5 day students
 - JCC members
 - Children enrolled in the 2019-2020 DPJCC After-School program
- You will be contacted by Lisa Lundy from the Children & Family Services Department after you register online to complete the payment process.
- **It is critical to fill out our “JSchooled Intake” form that will provide us with your child’s exact remote learning schedule, along with all codes, ID’s, passwords to log on to all platforms.**



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Closure Policy

Closure Policy If/When There is a Positive Case

- Only the class/cohort that has the positive case will temporarily close and will be deep cleaned. The minimum closure will be two days. The date of that class reopening will be determined on a case by case basis.
- We will work with the Broward Department of Health (DOH) to determine if (and which) children and staff members will require quarantining and/or testing. Each case will be determined on an individual basis as the circumstances vary per case. This technique will help avoid a program wide closure.
- The child/staff that tested positive must have a negative test result before returning to the program and be symptom-free.

Refund Policies

Refund Policy Due to Temporary Closure/Return to School

- If your child's class has a temporary closure, a 50% refund will be given for four or more missed consecutive days within that month/following month. If we temporarily close for three or less consecutive days, no refunds will be issued for those days within that month/following month.
- You may choose to withdraw from the program for future months; however, we cannot guarantee their space and there is a \$250 re-enrollment fee.
- If your child's school reopens for in person learning and you withdraw your child, we will issue a 50% refund on the days left in that month. You can choose to withdraw from JSchooled for future months, but the re-enrollment fee of \$250 will apply.
- Refunds will only be issued if the JCC closes (or in person school returns), not if a parent chooses to withdraw from the program for other reasons.
